



STREET BIKERS UNITED HAWAII SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Street Bikers United Hawaii believes that young people deserve the opportunity to succeed. The SBU Scholarship Fund offers financial aid to post-secondary bound SBU Member, children or grandchildren of SBU Members. SBU views this Scholarships Fund as a necessary investment into the future for scholarship recipients, the local community, the state and the country. The SBU-HI Scholarship will be given annually to one male and one female Applicant, each in the amount of \$500.00.

The Basic Requirements for Applicant and the SBU Member/Sponsor include:

For the Applicant:

- A Resident of State of Hawaii.
- Graduate of a Hawaii High School or an equivalent alternative learning program.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Proof of attendance at a recognized or accredited, two or four Year Trade School, College or University within the US (including US Territories).
- Either a Member of SBU for at least one year or a Child or Grandchild of an SBU Member who has maintained full paid-up membership status for a minimum of one year prior to and as of the application date.
- Minimum 2.7 GPA.
- Submit a personal statement and a separate essay on the designated topic specified on the Application Form
- Two letters of recommendation from non-family members familiar with the applicant's extra-curricular activities. (Examples: teacher, coach, employer, pastor)
- If the Applicant is an SBU member meeting the above requirements (i.e. Member of SBU for at least one year), no sponsorship is necessary.

For the Sponsor:

- Must be a SBU Member who has maintained full paid-up membership status for a minimum of one year prior to and as of the application date.
- Must be either blood relative of the applicant or "Hānai" as that term is interpreted by "Hawaiian Cultural Standards", which determination of "Hawaiian Cultural Standards" will be solely and exclusively determined by the STREET BIKERS UNITED HAWAII SCHOLARSHIP FUND's Executive Selection Committee, and whose determination will be final, binding and non-reviewable.
- Except by death, incapacity or similar circumstance, the Sponsoring SBU Member is expected to both maintain their SBU membership and support and encourage the Applicant to complete the course of study for which the Scholarship has been bestowed upon the Applicant.
